

QUICK REFERENCE: INFOTYPES

The following infotypes are maintained for hourly student appointments in SAPgui. The infotypes shaded blue are new infotypes added with the rollout of the SHA applications in SAPweb in May of 2012; the infotypes shaded green have been modified to include additional information.

Infotype #	Infotype Name	Description
0094	Residence Status	Stores citizenship status for hourly paid students and I-9 location (F, S, X are the only valid values for hourly paid students; an appointment can only be created in the SHA system if I-9 location value is 'F')
0554	Hourly Rate Assignment	Stores hourly rate for each hourly paid student appointment (position)
1000	Object	Stores the position #, name and description
1001	Relationships	Stores the relationships related to the appointment: Person to position – who holds the appointment Position to org unit – which department the position is in Position to job – which job the position is in Position to time group – the time group associated with the position Position to Position – Student’s position linked to supervisor’s position
1002	Description	Stores position description and optionally, may also store ‘other supervisor’ (e.g. external supervisor or grad student overseeing the appointment).
1005	Planned Compensation	Stores the minimum and maximum hourly rates for all hourly paid student jobs
1008	Acct Assign Feature	Stores personnel area and personnel subarea assigned to the appointment (position)
1011	Work Schedule	Stores the Planned hours per week for the appointment
1013	Employee Grp/Subgp	Stores the employee group and employee subgroup assigned to the appointment (position)
1018	Cost Distribution	Stores the cost object and % distribution for each hourly paid student appointment (position); standard infotype used by payroll processing
9018	Student Distributions	Stores the cost object and % distribution for each hourly paid student appointment (position); custom infotype used for MIT distribution
9022	Student Major	Stores student degree information such as MIT course number, the student’s major, degree being pursued, and graduation year
9050	Student Registration	Stores registration status and registration type. Only appointments with registration status EL or RE Only registration types R and X can be processed via the SHA applications.
9105	Add Student Attribute	Stores off campus flag for hourly paid students who work off campus; also stores UROP limit for UROP appointments
