

# How do I quote text in articles?

## Q: How do I quote text in articles?

### Answer

The quote style is specified by wiki markup. Simply put the `{quote}` markup tag on each side of the text you want included in the quote area. In the examples below you can see the wiki markup and the resulting box it creates.

Example `{quote}` wiki markup:
