

Jamf Pro - Extension Attributes

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Jamf Pro has many "extension attributes" which provide additional information to your computer inventory screen. Jamf Pro has several extension attributes IS&T has set up to help you better manage your Macintosh computers in your environment.

Add Extension Attributes to Your Inventory

- Each extension attribute needs to be added to your inventory screen. Do this following these steps:
 - Log into Casper. Click on the **gear** in the upper right hand corner.
 - Click **Computer Management** on the left hand side.
 - Click **Inventory Display** and click **edit** at the bottom.
 - Click on the **Extension Attributes** tab. Check the boxes for any extension attribute you might want.
 - Click **Save**.
 - Click **Computers** at the top and do a search. You will now see any fields you added.
