## Top 5 Answers

The `hdtop5-new` macro inserts a panel on a page that displays a simplified RSS feed of the top five articles labeled with the tag `ist-top-five`. It is called from the `sidebar` macro, which pulls in different sets of sidebar panels depending on which page it is on. The `hdtop5-new` is currently displayed on the Knowledge Base home page. It is called with code like this:
