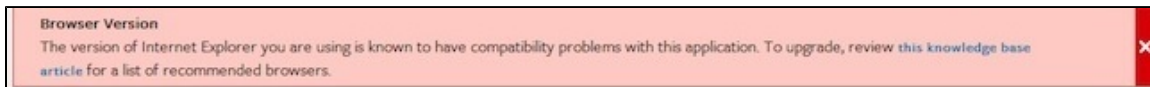

Outdated browser warning

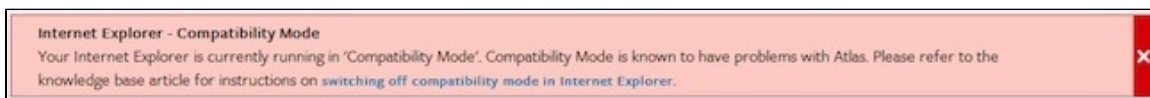
- If you are accessing Atlas and the new Hire Activities applications from an older browser version, such as Internet Explorer 9, 8 or lower, you may encounter display issues, such as overlaid text or control buttons not rendering properly.
- Atlas will display a warning message, instructing users to upgrade to a more recent Internet Explorer version.



The warning message directs users to a list of recommended browsers: [Recommended Browsers for Atlas](#).

Compatibility mode warning, Internet Explorer

- Internet Explorer has a feature called "Compatibility mode", which enables IE to emulate a previous browser version, enabling users to access websites that require an earlier IE version.
- Atlas will display best in Internet Explorer 10 or later.
- If you are running Internet Explorer in Compatibility mode for IE 8 or earlier, you will see a warning message:



Instructions for turning Compatibility mode on or off:

- [How to change your setting for Compatibility mode for Internet Explorer].
- Atlas will display best in Browser mode IE10 or higher, Document Standards.

Instructions for changing IE Compatibility mode version:

1. Display Internet Explorer Developer Tools:
 - Press **F12**.

OR

1. Press **Alt**, then follow the menu path **Tools > Developer Tools**.
2. In *Developer Tools* panel:
 - a. Change Browser mode to the desired version.
 - b. Change Document mode to the desired version.
