
Downloaded SAPgui report on Mac - error when opening

Downloaded SAPgui report on Mac - error when opening

Q: I downloaded a report from SAPgui on Macintosh, but when I try to open it, I get an error that the file may be corrupt.



Answer

Option 1 - Use the Text Import Wizard

- 1. Open a new Excel document
- 2. From the Data menu, select Get External Data >> Import Text File



- 3. Select the report file that you downloaded from SAPgui.
- 4. In the Text Import Wizard, select Delimited, then click Next



5. Select Tab and click Next



6. Select General and click Finish



Result: The file opens in Excel

Option 2 - Rename the file to .txt and open with Excel

- 1. Rename the file to .txt. You may also name the file as .txt when downloading from SAPgui
- Right-click the file and select Open With >> Excel
 Result: The Text Import Wizard may open. If so, follow these steps:
- 3. In the Text Import Wizard, select Delimited, then click Next



4. Select **Tab** and click **Next**



5. Select General and click Finish



Result: The file opens in Excel
