Google Chrome - Error 324 - No data received

I tried to visit a "https" web page at MIT, but got an error in Google Chrome:

No data received

Unable to load the webpage because the server sent no data.

Here are some suggestions:

- *Reload this webpage later.*

Error 324 (net::ERR_EMPTY_RESPONSE): The server closed the connection without sending any data.

While Google Chrome is not an IS&T supported web browser, the Help Desk will do our best to assist you in accessing MIT sites via Chrome.

Solutions

Option One: Delete MIT personal certificate and obtain a new one

In some cases, we have seen this error resolved by the following steps:

1. Delete your MIT personal certificate.
2. Obtain a new MIT personal certificate, at <http://ca.mit.edu>.

Option Two: Use an alternate web browser

If you get this error on <https://web.mit.edu/> sites, try another browser, such as Internet Explorer, Safari or Firefox.

Google Chrome uses some special techniques to load web pages faster, sometimes has trouble with certain MIT websites, such as <https://web.mit.edu/>

Chrome's special technique is called "false start", and works with most sites. You can read more information online. Here are a few links we found; you may be able to find more if you search online:
