
Starting July of 2021, IS&T has migrated to a new version of Sophos called Sophos Central. MIT users have until the summer of 2022 before the old version will stop receiving updates. Process



Prerequisites: You must have administrator rights to uninstall Sophos AntiVirus.


- Navigate to the Control Panel (Start > Control Panel).
- 2. Select Programs & Features.
- 3. Sophos Anti-Virus will have three entries:
 - Sophos Anti-Virus
 - Sophos AutoUpdate
 - Sophos Remote Management System



4. Select each of these entries and click the button labeled Uninstall.



In Windows 10 you will see 6 entries to uninstall: antivirus, auto update, endpoint defense, network threat protection, remote management, and system protection



- 5. Please wait until the first uninstall completes before moving to the next.
- 6. When all three entries have been uninstalled, restart your machine.
