## How can I upload multiple JV's, using SAPgui?



Note: this article refers to the SAPgui JV upload function. The preferred method is to use the JV upload feature in [Atlas](#) instead.

- For a JV with a small number of line items, use [Atlas](#). See: [Create a Journal Voucher](#)
- If you need to create a JV with numerous line items, you may wish to enter the line items into an Excel spreadsheet, then upload to SAP using the [SAPgui desktop application](#).
