i Starting July of 2021, IS&T has migrated to a new version of Sophos called **Sophos Central**. MIT users have until the summer of 2022 before the old version will stop receiving updates. 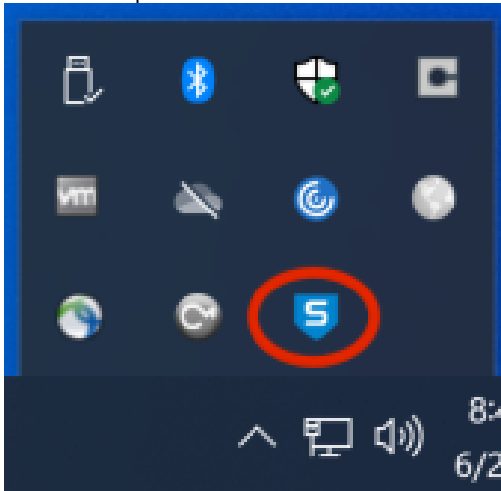
i By default, Sophos Anti-Virus for Windows, macOS, and Linux automatically checks for the latest virus definition and engine updates. If Sophos is installed properly, forcing the client to update – as detailed – is not necessary.

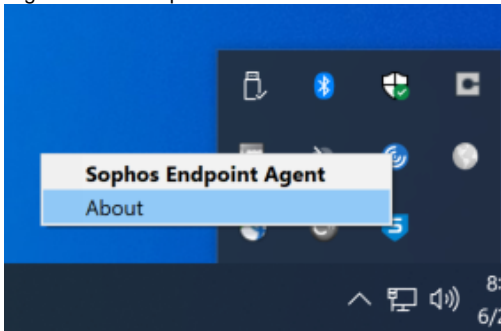

Windows

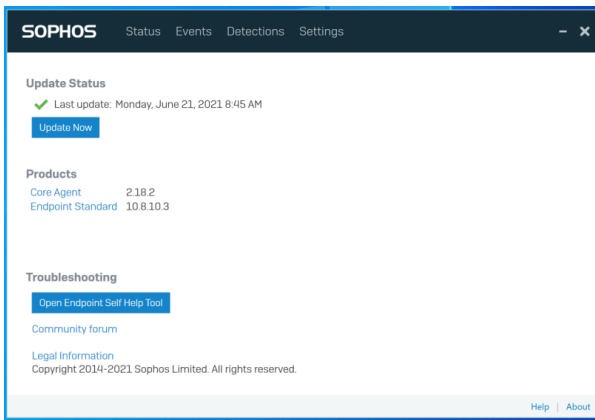
1. Locate the Sophos Anti-Virus icon in the Windows task bar.



2. Right-click the Sophos Anti-Virus icon and select **About**.

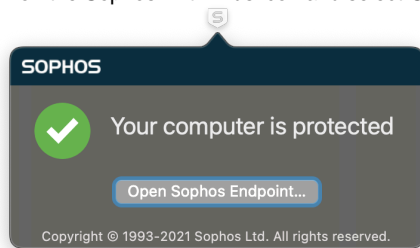


3. The Sophos info window will show the time and date of the last successful update. Click Update Now to trigger an immediate update.



macOS

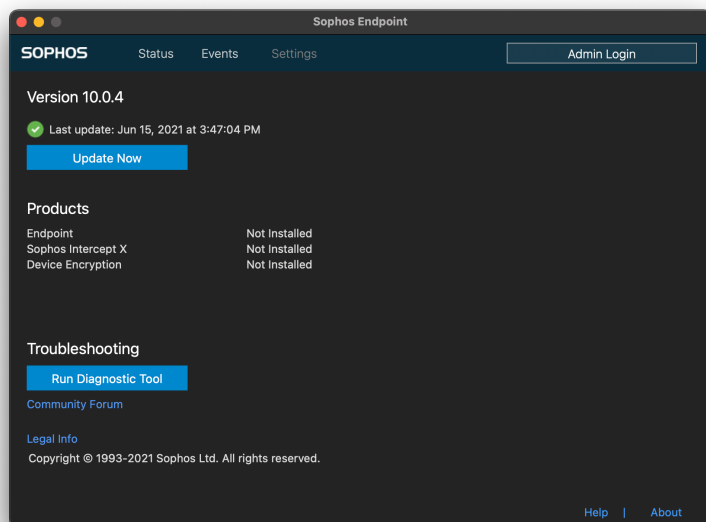
1. Locate the Sophos Anti-Virus icon in the macOS menubar.
2. Click on the Sophos Anti-Virus icon and select **Open Sophos Endpoint**.



3. Under the Sophos Endpoint menu, select **About Sophos Endpoint**.



4. Click **Update Now**.
