Answer

For Windows:

- 1. Navigate to Tools > Options
- 2. Click on the Privacy tab. It looks like a mask.
- 3. In the "History" section next to "Firefox will:", select Use Custom Settings for History from the drop down menu.
- 4. Check the box for "Clear history when Firefox closes"
- 5. Click Settings
- 6. Be sure the box for "Cache" is checked.
- 7. Click **OK**, then click **OK** again.

For MacOS:

- 1. Navigate to Firefox > Preferences
- 2. Click on the **Privacy** tab. It looks like a mask.
- 3. In the "History" section next to "Firefox will:", select Use Custom Settings for History from the drop down menu.
- 4. Check the box next to "Clear History when Firefox Closes."
- 5. Click Settings
- 6. Be sure the box for "Cache" is checked.
- 7. Close the "Preferences" window.
