## Linking Your Computer to MIT Dropbox

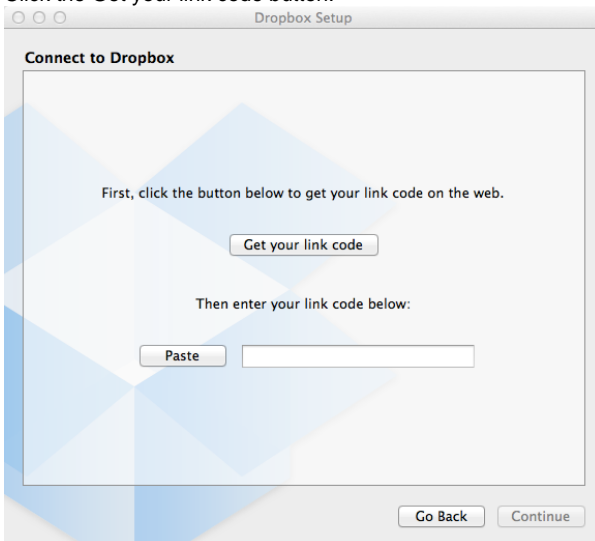
### Initial Set Up

If the Dropbox application on your computer is currently linked to your Dropbox account, you don't need to do anything — you can just keep using it without having to sign in.

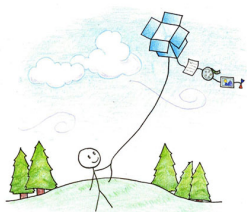
However, if you need to relink your computer or link a new one, you'll need the [latest version](#) of the application to connect to the MIT Enterprise account using Touchstone.

Follow these steps to link the computer to your account:

1. Run the Dropbox application.
2. Select **I already have a Dropbox account** and click **Continue**.
3. Enter your **full MIT email address** but leave the password field blank. Click **Continue**.
4. Click the Get your link code button.



5. Your information will be authenticated using your certificate. If you do not have a certificate installed, you will be directed to authenticate using MIT Touchstone.
6. A Dropbox page displaying a special code will open up. Click the **Copy link code** button, or select and copy the code manually.



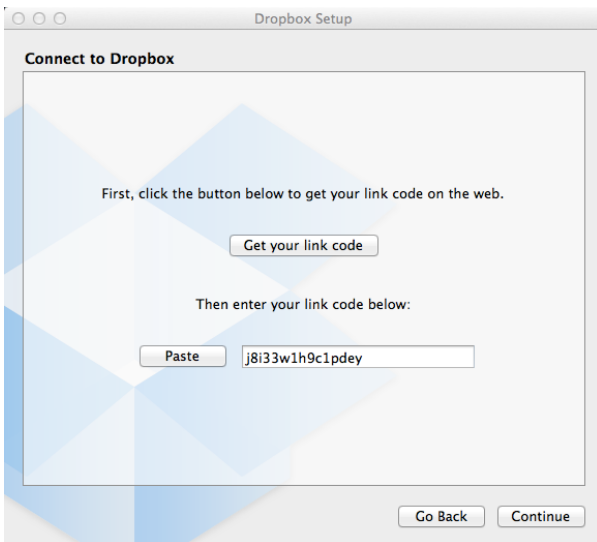
#### Get your link code

To finish linking your computer to you@company.com, go back to the Dropbox installer and enter the following link code:

j8i33w1h9c1pdey

7. Go back to the Dropbox application and click **Paste**, or manually paste the code into the field and click Continue.



8. Once submitted, your account will be linked to your MIT Dropbox.
