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Starting July of 2021, IS&T has migrated to a new version of Sophos called Sophos Central. 

The Sophos alert says threats were detected.




When you open the Quarantine Manager, you see:




You can click the padlock at the bottom corner to unlock the page, and will be asked for a Mac Administrator password.




You can select a threat line, and press the Clean Up Threat button.




You will be warned that the Clean Up may delete files.



Clean Up may take a few minutes.



To view details of a threat, click the triangle by **Threat Details** to open an information area at the bottom. You can see the Path and Filename of the threat. The example shown is a bad attachment that came in email.
