You can configure your mobile device in Jamf Pro for email with a configuration profile. To do this log in to the JSS and go to your mobile device site and do the following:

- 1. Select Configuration Profiles.
- 2. Click New.
- 3. Under General give the profile a name such as "Email."
- 4. Assign a category.
- Select the Distribution Method.
- 5. Click **Exchange ActiveSync** and then configure the settings as in the image below.
