Configure Android Native Applications

Exact instructions can vary from brand to brand. These instructions should work on most Android devices.

- 1. Go to Settings > Accounts & sync
- 2. Click the + sign to add an account.
- 3. Select Exchange Active Sync
- 4. Enter your full MIT email address in the form username@mit.edu and your password. Click Next
- 5. Choose your ActiveSync settings and click Next
- Enter your account name in the form username@mit.edu and click Finish Setup Result: Your email is configured.

If you have an older Android device, you may need to enter the server as well as your username. It is:
