

#### **Answer**


At some point you may want to review previous versions of an article, restore one of those older versions, or compare versions to find out what changed.

#### To access an article's history


- 1. Make sure you're logged in.
- 2. Navigate to the article.



4. Click on View Page History



Result: The history page for the article opens. You can see a list of previous versions of the article along with the creation dates and authors.



### To view a previous version of an article

- 1. Navigate to the history page as described above.
- 2. In the Version column, click on the version number of the previous version of the article you wish to view. *Result:* The previous version of the article is displayed.

## To restore a previous version of an article

- 1. Navigate to the history page as described above.
- 2. In the Operations column, click on **Restore this Version** next to the version of the article you want to be the live, publicly visible one. *Result:* You are asked to confirm that you want to revert the page to the selected version.
- 3. Click OK.

Result: The version you selected is made the current version. When you view the article, this is the version you will see.

### To compare versions of an article

- 1. Navigate to the history page as described above.
- 2. Check the box next to the versions you want to compare.
- 3. Click the **Compare Selected Versions** button at the top of the list of versions.

  \*Result: A comparison of the two pages is displayed. It informs you what was added, deleted and changed between the selected versions.
