## **Linking Your Computer to MIT Dropbox**


## **Initial Set Up**

If the Dropbox application on your computer is currently linked to your Dropbox account, you don't need to do anything — you can just keep using it without having to sign in.

However, if you need to relink your computer or link a new one, you'll need the latest version of the application to connect to the MIT Enterprise account using Touchstone.

Follow these steps to link the computer to your account:


- 1. Run the Dropbox application.
- 2. Select I already have a Dropbox account and click Continue.
- 3. Enter your full MIT email address but leave the password field blank. Click Continue.
- 4. Click the Get your link code button.



- 5. Your information will be authenticated using your certificate. If you do not have a certificate installed, you will be directed to authenticate using MIT Touchstone.
- 6. A Dropbox page displaying a special code will open up. Click the **Copy link code** button, or select and copy the code manually.



 $7. \ \ \text{Go back to the Dropbox application and click } \textbf{Paste}, \text{ or manually paste the code into the field and click } \textbf{Continue}.$ 



8. Once submitted, your account will be linked to your MIT Dropbox.
