

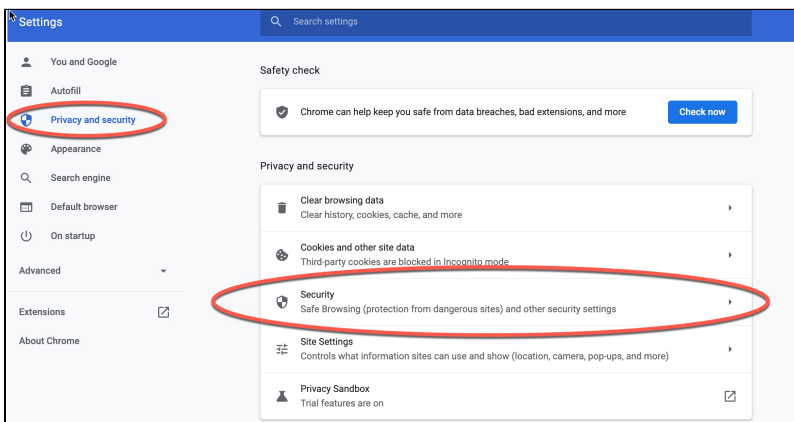
Delete MIT Personal Certificates in Chrome for Windows

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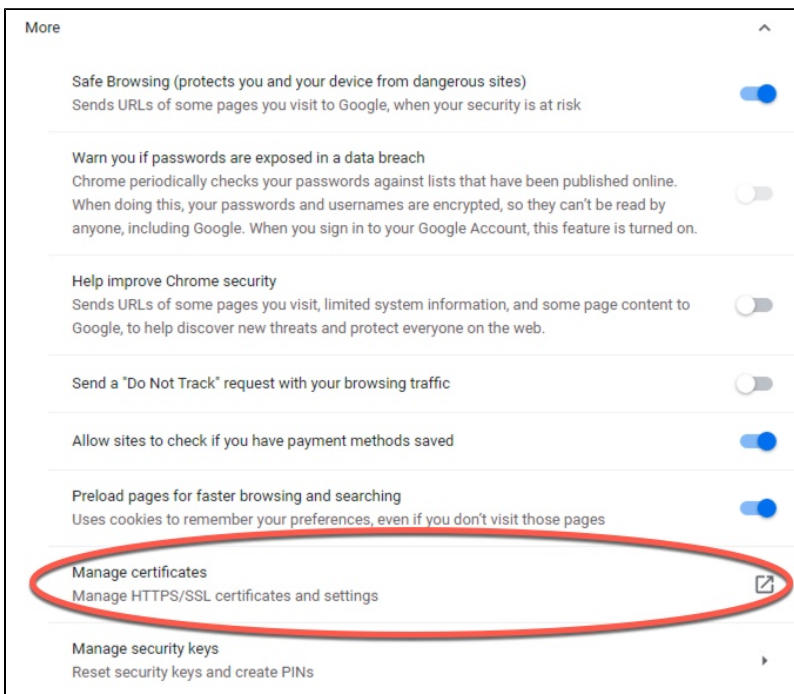


WARNING: If you have used S/MIME for email encryption, you should [export certificates](#), in order to retain a backup copy, before deleting them from the browser.

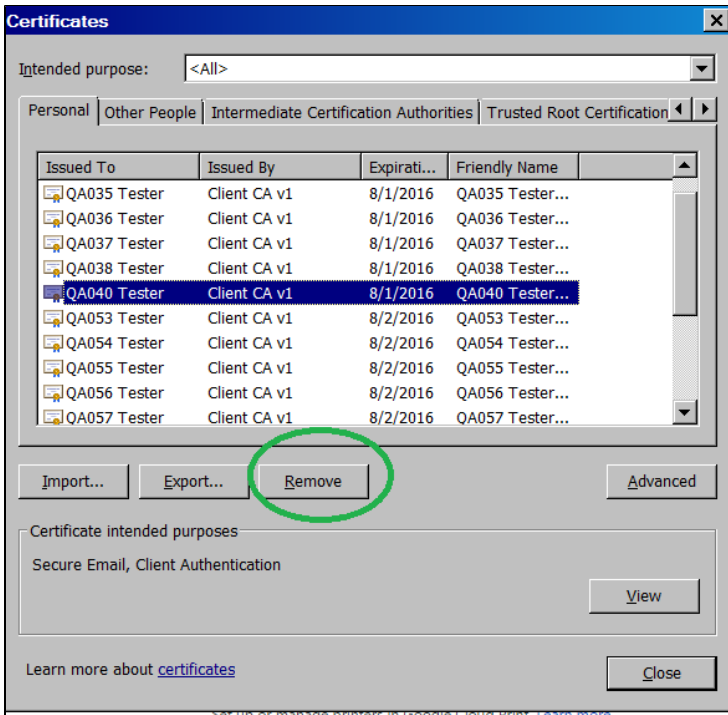
1. In your Chrome browser, go to <chrome://settings/privacy>
2. In the top "Privacy and Security" section, select "More".



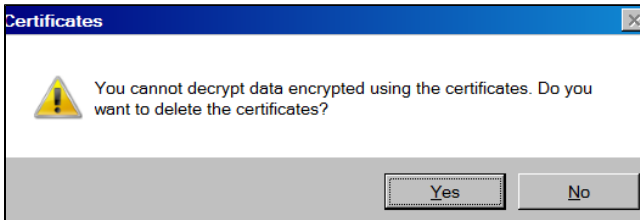
3. Scroll down and select "Manage Certificates".
