- 1. In Internet Explorer, go to **Tools > Internet Options**. The following window will appear.
- 2. Click Content to access the Content tab.
- 3. Click Certificates. The Certificates window will appear.
- 4. Select any extra or expired certificates and click Remove. A warning will appear.
- 5. Click Yes, and confirm that you have one, non-expired certificate.
