

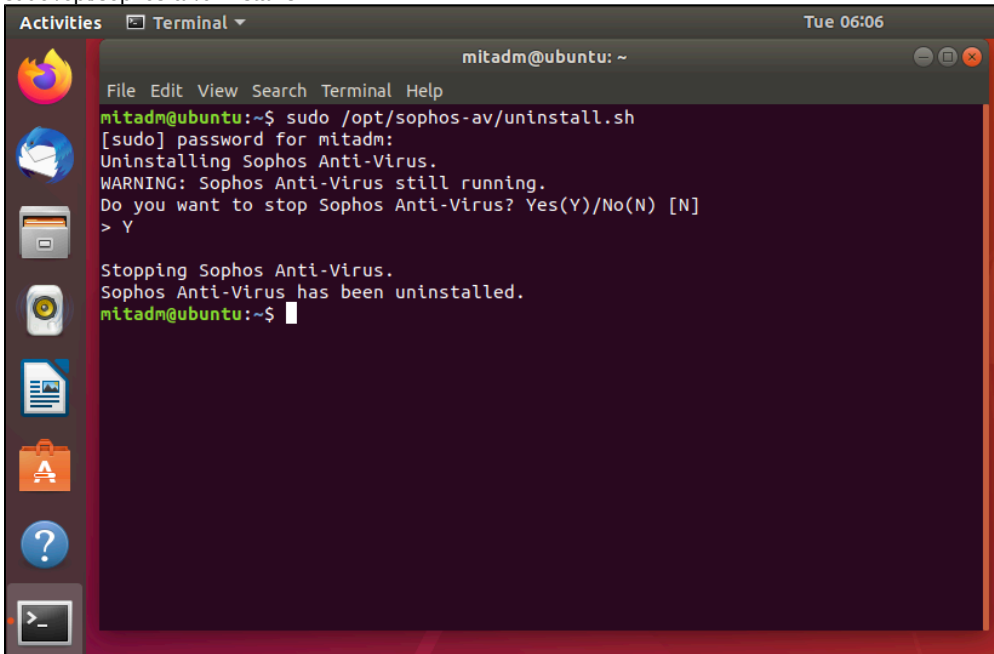
Sophos Central - Uninstall Instructions for Linux

Q: How do I uninstall Sophos Central for Linux

i Starting July of 2021, IS&T has migrated to a new version of Sophos called **Sophos Central**. MIT users have until the summer of 2022 before the old version will stop receiving updates. 1. To uninstall Sophos Anti-Virus for Linux, run the uninstall script:

```
sudo /opt/sophos-av/uninstall.sh
```

2. If the savd daemon is running, the script prompts you to stop it
