DTRs Print in Portrait When I Print to the MLOC Print Queue in SAPgui

This is a known bug in the [MLOC print queue](#).

If you choose to use MLOC as your output device in SAPgui, you must print your Detailed Transaction Reports through the Print Preview process:

1. Run your report as usual.
2. Click on the **Print** button.
3. Click on the **green checkmark**.
4. Click on the **Print Preview** button (this will display a preview of the report).
5. Click on the printer icon on that screen.

If you do not click on **Print Preview** before printing the report, it will print in portrait orientation, instead of landscape, and the right side of the report will be cut off.
