Adding Links to Your Drupal Page

You can create a link to a web page which will open in the current browser tab. You can specify that the new link opens in a separate tab or window.

Creating a Link

- 1. Select the link text or image, or click where you would like the link to appear.
- 2. Click the Link icon in the toolbar. The Link window opens.
- 3. Type or paste the target URL.
- 4. Click the Target tab to select a new behavior (e.g., Open in new window).
- 5. Click OK. Click Save, then test the link.
