

Dell Workaround for Firefox

Q: The links on the Dell website do not work when I use Firefox. How do I get the website to function?

Answer

This is a cross-site scripting error caused by part of the page being coded in http and part in https. To get the site to function, follow the below steps:

1. Enter the *Dell* web page via eCat
2. Click on any of the customize links

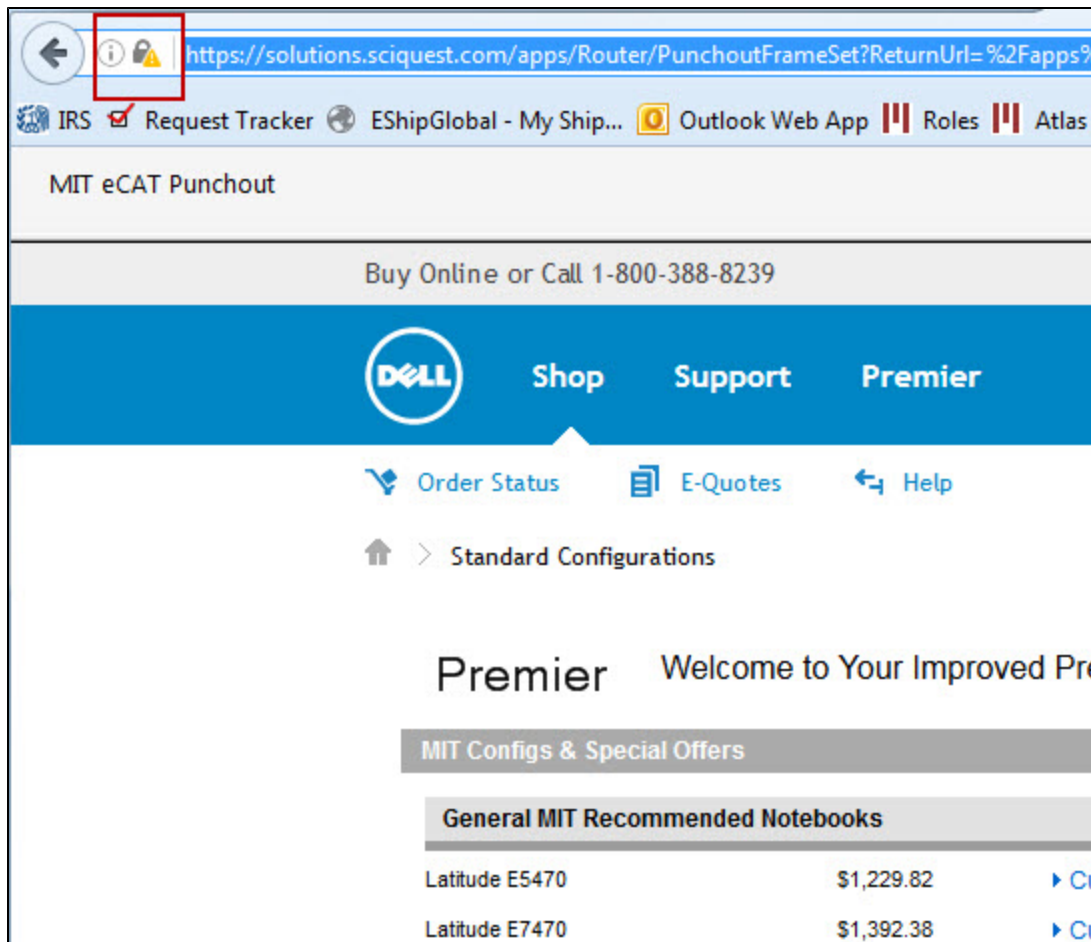

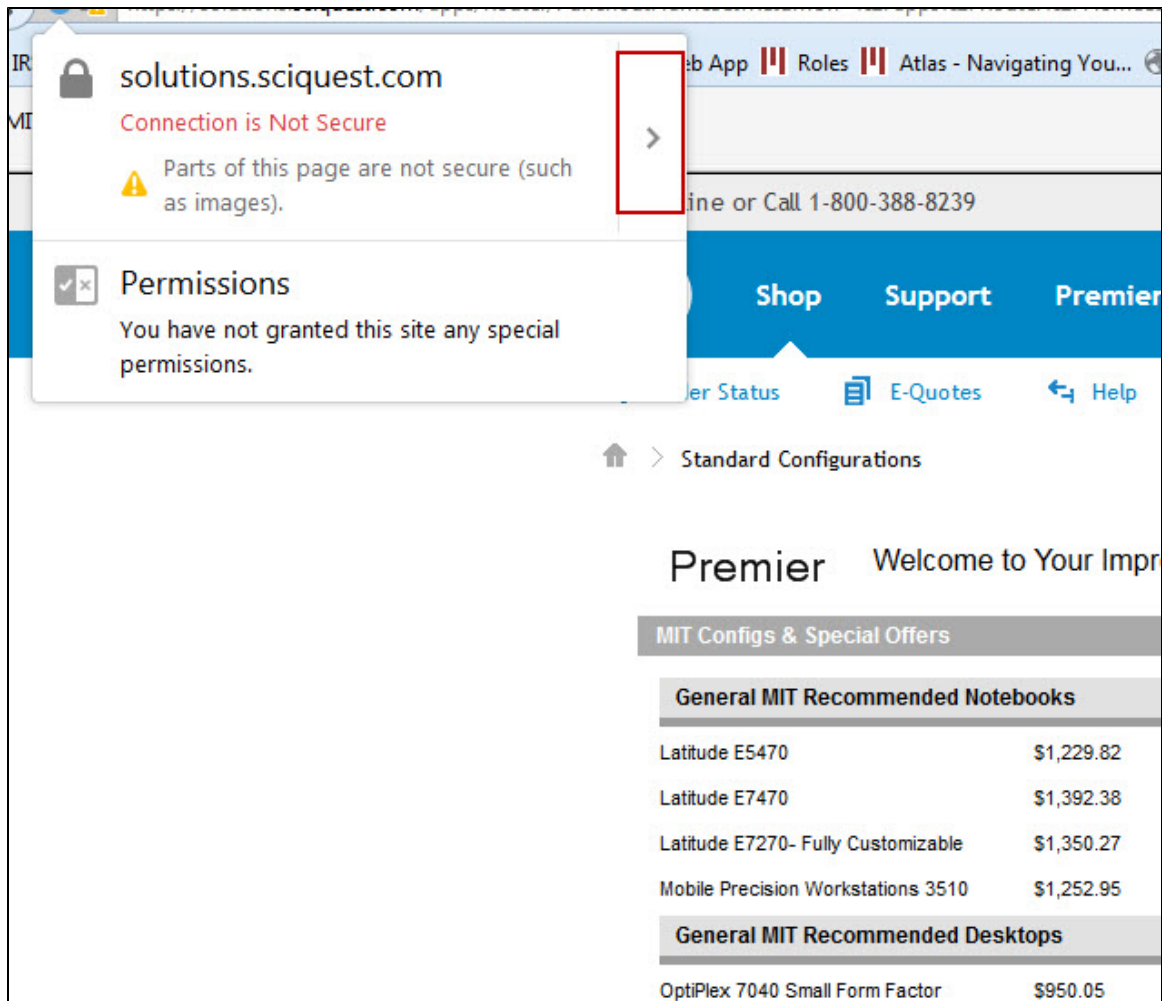

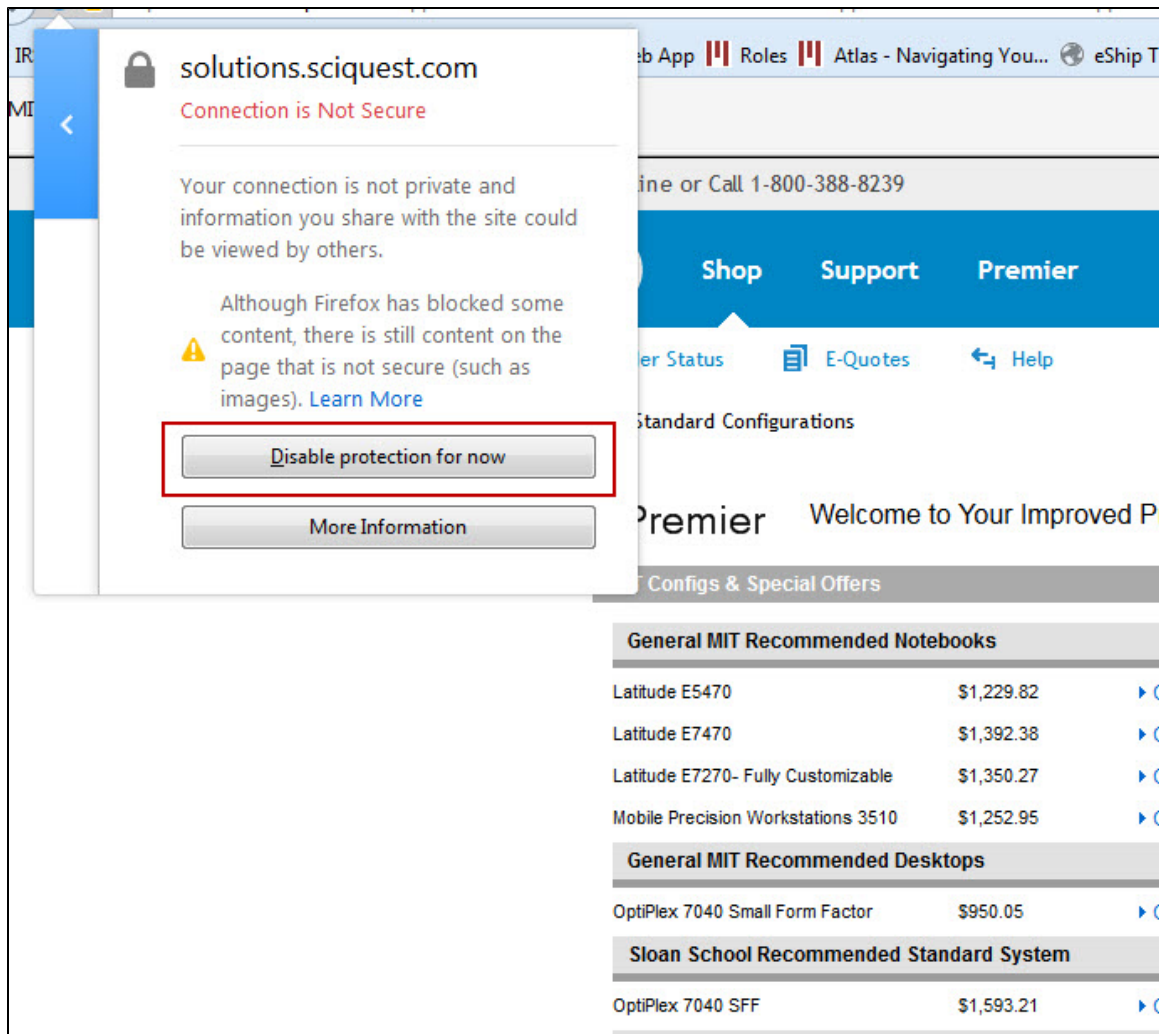
3. Click on the **lock and yellow triangle icon** in the top left corner of the page.



4. Click on the **arrow** to right of the red *Connection is Not Secure* message



5. Click **Disable protection for now**



Once these steps have been completed, the page will reload and all the links should function. Note that this will have to be done again if you close Firefox.
