What are categories?

Categories are a way of organizing Knowledge Base articles into groups by topic. Users can browse the categories to obtain knowledge on a topic area instead of searching for a specific answer. Note that not all Knowledge Base articles are included in the category structure. They are only added when authors add articles to the categories.

Where are the categories?

How do I add an article to a category?

You add articles to categories by adding the category label to the article. Category labels are formatted c-categoryname. You can find the category label for any category by navigating to that category and scrolling to the bottom of the list of articles in that category.
