Login Instructions



- 1. Enter your MIT ID number: The 9 digit number printed on your MIT ID card.
- 2. Enter your password:
 - First-Time Users: Your 8 digit temporary password is the following: the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number followed by the 4 digits of your year of birth.
 - Unsure of your Password: Click Forgot Password, and you will be assigned a temporary password after being asked your security question. Note: You'll be prompted for "User Name". Enter 9-digit MIT ID number.



Establishing a New Password

If you used a temporary password, you must establish a new password. The password must be 6 to 10 alphanumeric characters with at least 2 numbers. This new password cannot be 50% or more similar to any previous password you have established. You will be asked to re-enter your password.
