

How Do I Create a Custom 404 Page?

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Answer:

When a page is not found a custom 404 page will display a message you create. Drupal Cloud custom 404 pages are associated with your Site information.

1. Create a basic page and add your message. You will need the page name in Step 4.
2. From the Admin menu, click **Configuration**, then **System**, then **Site information**.
3. Scroll to **Error Pages** where you will see two fields.
4. In the *Default 404 (not found)* page enter the name of your new 404 page.

You can also follow the same process to add a custom 403 Access Denied page.

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
