

How Can I Customize My Site Favicon

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Answer:

A favicon is a small image which appears on the web page tab at the top. It must be 32x32 pixels, be 8 or 24 bits and have the .png or .ico extension. Favicons are associated with your theme.

To add a favicon:

1. On the *Admin menu* click **Appearance**, then **Settings**.
2. Click on your theme in the top right.
3. Scroll to the bottom of the overlay and click **Shortcut icon settings**.
4. Uncheck *Use the default shortcut icon*.
5. Click the **Browse** button, then locate and select your favicon image. Click OK. The Path to custom icon field will be filled in for you.
6. Click **Save configuration**.

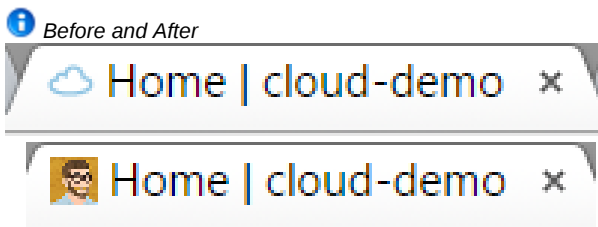
