Enabling or disabling tools in Canvas

A number of native Canvas tools and features, as well as LTI tools such as Zoom, Piazza, and Gradescope, can be enabled or disabled in the left side menu of a Canvas course site. This is done via the course navigation settings.

Canvas offers more details on changing course navigation in their documentation.

To enable a tool

- 1. Click "Settings" in the left menu of your class site.
- 2. Click the "Navigation" tab.
- 3. Scroll to the bottom of the page and find the tool you would like to enable. This will usually be near the bottom of the page.
- 4. Drag the tool into the top list of the page to enable it in the left menu.
- 5. Scroll to the bottom and click "Save" to save this change.
- 6. Upon saving, the page should refresh, and tool should now be visible in the left menu.

To disable a tool

- 1. Click "Settings" in the left menu of your class site.
- 2. Click the "Navigation" tab.
- 3. Find the tool you would like to disable in the top list of the page.
- 4. Drag the tool from the top list of the page to the bottom list to hide it in the left menu.
- 5. Scroll to the bottom and click "Save" to save this change.
- 6. Upon saving, the page should refresh, and tool should now be removed from the left menu.
