

Finding an Athena directory path from the web site's URL

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If a client doesn't know the directory path for their web site hosted on web.mit.edu, you can find the directory path by using the **attach** command on Athena.

For example, if you want to know what the AFS directory is for web.mit.edu/mit-greece. Log in to Athena and type `attach mit-greece` and the path will be returned.

```
athena% attach mit-greece
attach: /afs/athena.mit.edu/activity/m/mit-greece attached to /mit/mit-greece for filesystem
mit-greece
```
