Each time you open Safari and access a cert protected site get the following pop up dialog:



Context

- Safari 11.0

Fix

- Open Keychain Access
- Click on keys, under Category (bottom left)
- Click on Name column header to sort by name
- Locate your MIT personal certificate, "*yourname* Certificate"
- Double click on that line
- Click on 'Access Control'
- Click on the + sign. Webkit.Framework folder should automatically open. (/System/Library/Frameworks/WebKit.framework/)
- Navigate to Versions > A > XPC Services
- Select **com.apple.WebKit.Networking.xpc**
- Click Add
- Click Save Changes
